### 1. Academics, Class attendance and Reporting to School:

First semester of Academic year 2021/2022 commences on 17<sup>th</sup> May 2021 and closes on 13<sup>th</sup> August 2021. Semester TWO results will be pinned at the Institute's notice board at the beginning of semester one, students who will have not attained 50% pass mark in any course unit will have to retake when next offered, and those who fail more than a half of the total number of course units in a semester shall be required to repeat that semester. Registration for students to sit any examination will continue to be based on full payment of Institute dues (Nil Balance) and attainment of 75% class attendance in any course unit as provided for in the rules issued on admission. All students MUST report to school in the first week of the semester without fail to allow effective coverage of the syllabus. Effective teaching will begin on Tuesday, 18<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

# '(b) Fees payment policy

- i. Fees will be paid using bank-in-slips payable to <u>The Hotel and Tourism Training Institute</u> through <u>Account Number 01463656075963 in DFCU Bank</u>. Alternatively pay fees by Bank Draft In favor of 'The Hotel and Tourism Training Institute Jinja.
- ii. No cash or personal cheques are allowed.
- iii. Students are required to pay a minimum of 60% of the total fees paid before reporting and the balance within 30 days. Students who report without any payment of fees will be sent back home.
- iv. Students have been cleared to be Non residence and the fees are as per the structure.
- 3. Guild Fees: A sum of 17,500/= (15,000+2,500/=) should be paid towards guild activities per Semester. No student will be registered at the beginning of the semester without a paid up bank slip.

  These monies are payable on GUILD Account Number 2041900009 in Bank of Africa (U) LTD Jinja branch in favor of HTTI GUILD.

# 4. Institute Requirements

Every student MUST bring one ream of photocopying paper (DOUBLE A/ BLUE MOON), a pair of rubber gloves for cleaning, a wine opener and 5 copies of colored passport photographs every semester

- 5. Welfare / hostel requirements from Dean of Students' desk
  Students should be provided with the following; 10 rolls of toilet paper, 2 mild roll on deodorants, a mosquito net, 5 packets of sanitary towels, an umbrella, a water bottle, a 10 litre jerican
- 6. Medical Services:

The institute clinic is only equipped to handle simple illness; Parents/Guardians are therefore advised to be prepared to clear bills for illnesses that require attention beyond what the Institute can handle.

- 7. A mandatory Pregnancy test shall be administered to all female students at the beginning of the semester and will be arranged for by the Dean and Institute Nurse. Please note; Pregnancy if not declared may lead to cancellation of admission.
- 8. Study Tours- Mandatory to all students

CHO and CPB students will be proceeding for a study tour to any one of these destinations Mbale, Entebbe and Kampala and they are expected to make a contribution which is inclusive in the fees structure
